

Pre-ETS Referral Guide

Potentially Eligible Students:

- Any student between the ages of 14 and 21 with an Individualized Education Plan
- Any student between the ages of 14 and 21 with a 504 Plan
- Any student between the ages of 14 and 21 with a documented disability
 - Including, but not limited to, Anxiety, Attention-Deficit / Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD), Depression, Asthma, Diabetes, Specified Learning Disability (SLD),
 Oppositional Defiant Disorder (ODD), Obsessive-Compulsive Disorder (OCD), and various eating disorders.

To Refer a Potentially Eligible Student:

- Please send a completed MRC Pre-ETS Referral Form and documentation of the student's disability to Nina Benvenuto at NBenvenuto@bfair.org.
 - Disability documentation could include a copy of the student's IEP, 504 Plan, or a note from their physician.
- Upon receiving the referral, BFAIR will submit the student's information to the Massachusetts Rehabilitation Commission (MRC) for approval and contact the student to schedule an intake meeting.
